1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 The purpose of the report is to update Members following a consultation on possible location options for future Transport for the North Scrutiny committee meetings.

2. Executive Summary

- 2.1 Following the issue of location being raised at the previous Scrutiny Committee, Members asked that this issue be looked at further.
- 2.2 Members were keen for future meetings to be held in more central locations which were easily accessible and have a mainline station.
- 2.3 An e-mail consultation was sent to Members in order to gather opinions and present recommendations to Members.
- 2.4 The consensus from the responses received had Manchester and Leeds as the ideal locations with York and Preston also being mentioned.

3. Considerations

3.1 Manchester Town Hall is currently being renovated and is therefore unavailable. In order for Manchester to be used as a location whilst this work is being done another civic building will need to be found that is close to the station. Other locations in Manchester can be looked at but budget would need to be considered.

4. Recommendation

4.1 That Scrutiny Committee **agrees** to the proposal that future Transport for the North Scrutiny Committee meetings should take place in either Leeds, York or Manchester subject to a suitable venue being found in Manchester.



4.2 That the Scrutiny Committee decide and agree on a list of other possible, suitable alternative locations that could be used, that are on a main railway line and within walking distance of a station.
