


Our vision is of a thriving North of England where modern transport connections drive economic growth and support an excellent quality of life.


About Northern Powerhouse Rail

This is a transformational programme to better connect the key economic areas and cities of the North.



Northern Powerhouse Rail will be delivered over a 30-year period through a combination of new line, use of planned HS2 infrastructure, and major upgrades to existing routes.
